

Important: Before installing, please make sure there are rubber gaskets inside the fittings at both ends of the water supply hoses. Missing rubber gaskets can cause

water leakage.

Slide the bottom cover into the slots on bottom surface of the unit as shown in the following figure. Fix it with two screws attached with the unit.

at the back of the washer.

3. Turn on the HOT and COLD water supplies and check all the water supply intake connections and the faucets for water leaks.


Connect the drain hose The drain hose can be positioned in three different ways

2. Connect the ends of the water supply hoses to the water supply inlet connections




